A license to practice Acupuncture does not authorize a person to practice medicine and surgery in this state, and that the services of an Acupuncturist must not be regarded as diagnosis and treatment by a person licensed to practice medicine and must not be regarded as medical opinion or advice. I have not had any license, registration, or certificate revoked by any state, local or federal agency.

**Acupuncture Information and informed consent:** Acupuncture is performed by the insertion pre-sterilized, disposable acupuncture needles through the skin and the application of heat or electrical stimulation to the skin, or both, at certain points on the body. The benefits and risk of receiving Acupuncture and Chinese medical treatment have been explained to me. Although rare, certain side effects may result from Acupuncture and I understand that each procedure of treatment has specific risks and benefits. I have been informed the risk and benefits of the procedures and products listed below that apply to my treatment: (1) Acupuncture needles to stimulate points and meridians, including the specific risk of needling certain points; (2) Use of mechanical, magnetic, laser or electrical stimulation of Acupuncture points, particularly in instances where such stimulation applied across the midline of the trunk or in patients of history of heart trouble; (3) Moxibustion, heater; (4) Herbal medicine; (5) Acupressure, Tui na, massage; (6) Cupping; (7) TDP infrared heat lamp; (8) Plaster
